



The concept

The aim of the new office concept is to intensify dialogue between employees. The 68 spacious and open-plan workstations are spread over two storeys. Light-brown lockers dominate the office furnishings. The acoustic partitions between two workstations are also a friendly light-brown colour. The black office swivel chairs, on the other hand, are modelled on the dark carpet and thus blend inconspicuously into the room. Simply Services AG deliberately chose the colours in the new offices to create a pleasant atmosphere for employees and customers.

One highlight is the lounge with kitchen, elevated countertop, and inviting swivel armchairs in lead grey. Other zones such as meeting and consultation rooms or retreats complement the two open-plan offices.






The concept

The high-ceilinged rooms at the Carletto AG site are kept simple with exposed concrete, while the colour scheme of dark turquoise, crimson and pinewood lends energy to the ambiance. However, it's the toys displayed throughout the office that take centre stage.

"We made the deliberate decision to keep the desks and swivel chairs as unobtrusive as possible", says Lilly Gygax, responsible for marketing at the Carletto Group. "We wanted it to be the interior colour scheme, the colourful accents on the shelfs, and most of all our brightly coloured toys that bring our cked together or kept separate as desired. office to life." The unassuming height-adjustable desks, swivel chairs and acoustic partitions create a subtle backdrop to the welcoming, colourful atmosphere.

Some of the shelves have irregular round openings in their backs; others are fully closed or open. They give structure to the generous space, while providing plenty of storage. There are also tambour cabinets and lockers for additional storage.

As well as the bright, friendly work spaces, there are several options for smaller gatherings – three meeting rooms, a showroom and a workshop area. The larger areas are equipped with triangular tables on rollers - these offer maximum flexibility as they can be cli-







The Touring Club Suisse (TCS) recently centralised its administrative headquarters at a site in the German-speaking part of Switzerland. Some 530 employees, previously spread over six locations, have now moved into the newly-built offices in Ostermundigen. These offer a total of 566 workplaces, spread over a generous 9000 m² of office space. The previous sites had no consistent interior furnishing concept, as Marin Pavlovic, Head of Real Estate for the Touring Club Suisse, explains. "The furniture at the different locations consisted of a mishmash of brands, colours and materials - sometimes even within one and the same office. Relocating the furniture would have been pointless due to the high cost of adjustments and acquiring additional furnishings." As a result, TCS opted for a completely fresh approach to furnishing the new offices in Ostermundigen. The timeless office design which Lista Office LO helped to develop combines a judicious mix of open plan spaces for up to 100 employees with one-person, two-person and four-person offices. The site also houses conference rooms and a quiet room. Most of the employees had never worked in an open plan office before, so it's been a huge change for them - but feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. "We've been able to observe more momentum and meaningful interactions between employees. The different departments collaborate more closely and information is shared more

efficiently. Everything is closer to hand," summarises Marin Pavlovic with a satisfied smile. The employees are also delighted with the height-adjustable desks that enable them to work more ergonomically.

As well as modernising the interior design, TCS also focused on digitalisation. As a result, workplace storage space for private belongings and business documents was kept to a minimum. "This was part of our digitalisation strategy," explains Marin Pavlovic. "By providing less space for paperwork, we're encouraging our staff to digitalise their processes." TCS based their calculations for the amount of storage space per employee on an average value and followed the advice given by Lista Office LO.

The new pebble grey furnishings harmonise beautifully with the timeless light grey of most of the walls, while warmer colours have been included in the carpets, individual wall areas and selected furnishings to add a more homely touch to the office atmosphere. 90 % of the furnishings were supplied by Lista Office LO, and Marin Pavlovic is full of praise for the interior furnishings specialist. "We benefitted from their professional, proactive advice, and are delighted with the high quality furnishings," he says. "The planning and implementation phases ran smoothly and on schedule from start to finish. We can warmly recommend Lista Office LO!"



















For the developers, 76 ergonomic workstations have been set up in "Team Zones" on three "Working Floors". The freely adjustable standing desks supplied by Lista Office LO offer superb working comfort and freedom to move. Stefania Rosati is enthusiastic about the benefits: "They help promote employee health and boost efficiency. 





The move to the spacious new premises in the city's industrial quarter brought with it a number of challenges. As well as dividing

The concept

The Insel Group's workplace standard was first developed in collaboration with Lista Office LO several years ago. "A uniform standard for the office outfitting makes it straightforward to manage the office space; in particular, it makes life much easier for rotations – the individuals have to relocate, but the surroundings are already fixed", explains Markus Wasmer, Subproject Lead in charge of the "Anna-Seiler-Haus" building project. The new block, opened in September 2023, is the main building at Inselspital Bern, and is now the second project to implement the Group's workspace standard.

The working areas feature ergonomic sitting/standing desks, swivel chairs, and acoustic dividers. The main working areas are complemented by additional spaces such as meeting rooms and cubicles for telephone calls or dictation.

"When defining the workplace types, we select between 'individual' and 'flexible'/'neutral'", explains Markus Wasmer, describing the dynamic model. "If staff are spending several hours of their working day in a place, we want them to feel at home there." Other than lockers, the Insel Group has mostly avoided providing personalised storage space, focusing instead on the digital environment.


The shared-use areas feature wooden walls and colourful furniture and upholstery, which give these social areas fresh accents and a welcoming feel. The high quality of the design and materials used lift the ambiance and help create a sense of wellbeing in these spaces, notes Markus Wasmer.




To create the right conditions for implementing Swiss Learning Plan 21, the school wanted to refurbish the classrooms, following the principles of the Chur model. In this model, the learning environment and classroom layout play central roles. 


Paradiesli Schoolhouse

In the Paradiesli Schoolhouse, active learning is the order of the day.

The LO Edge desk and dividers from the LO Move system can be clicked together, making it child's play to implement Switzerland's modern learning plan Lehrplan 21, while also creating an ergonomic workspace.

Contemporary schoolteaching uses a variety of spatial settings for students to learn in. Sometimes the whole class is being taught as a block; sometimes small group discussions are underway; other times are for focused individual work. Thus today's classroom needs to be equipped for all these modes. The question: what's the best way to enable students to transition effectively between these different learning types within their classroom? Ideally, without causing a lot of noise or requiring outside help, and bearing in mind the limited space available in the typical classroom.



The concept


Before the refurbishments, the Arnegg site was home to IT and Order handling. After the office refit, the CFO, HR, Controlling and Accounting departments also moved in. 

The coffee area boasts a friendly colour scheme and a variety of seating options that make the space inviting for breaks, relaxing, discussions or work. This welcoming space, along with the

newly open-plan offices, fosters casual encounters. Markus Basler is delighted by the results: "I value the personal contact with the different departments – I can ask questions or raise issues directly". Circular windows in the coffee area offer a direct view into the assembly workshop where Lista Office LO is busy manufacturing new office furniture for its customers.





